## **Applying for the North Carolina Concealed Carry Handgun Permit:**

- 1.) Obtain a certificate of completion from an approved Firearms Training Course.
- 2.) Contact your local Sheriff's office to schedule an appointment to submit your paperwork. Ask what documentation and information you need to bring.
- 3.) When you go to the Sheriff's office, you will need the following items:
  - a.) Original (embossed) "Certificate of Completion" from this course.
  - b.) Valid form of ID, (North Carolina Drivers License).
  - c.) A \$90.00 processing Fee. Check with your Sheriff's office for valid payment types.
  - d.) Your DD214 if served in military (honorable discharge).
- 4.) During your time at the Sheriff's office expect to spend 45-60 minutes doing the following:
  - a.) Filling out the CCH application.
  - b.) A background check will be conducted along with fingerprints taken.
  - c.) You will be required to fill our some medical questionnaires.

## Once you receive your permit:

- 1.) Your permit will be valid for 5 years.
- 2.) You will be required to carry your permit and one other form of valid identification when carrying a concealed firearm.
- 3.) When approached by an officer, you must notify them immediately that you have a valid concealed handgun permit and you are in possession of a concealed handgun.

**REMEMBER: DO NOT** attempt to draw or display your permit or handgun unless asked to do so by any law enforcement officer.
